Monday's presentations will cover shellfish diseases and environmental concerns, such as creosote removal, outbreaks of *vibrio parahaemolyticus* and oil spills. Tuesday's session will focus on geoduck culture, including newly funded Sea Grant research and the ecological effects of planting, rearing and harvesting.
